We beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant regarding the owners proposal to carry out the special surveys of the machinery of the above vessel under the continuous survey arrangements.

The matter has been discussed with the Owners, who wish to point out that when the last special survey was held at Kiel very extensive repairs were carried out to the hull and they therefore expect that at the next special survey only a limited amount of repairs will be required, so that they have good reasons to expect that the survey can be completed in a short time.

In view of the heavy dimensions of the machinery it is feared that this part of the survey cannot be carried out within the same time, and this is the background for the owners desire to spread the survey over a longer period i.e. using the
