S. The Committee have had before them a report of survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff (April/June 1947) from which it is noted that the vessel has been under survey for docking, damage and conversion to oil burning. It is stated that no timber was available for fitting ceiling on the No.3 tank top, and that arrangements would be made for this to be done on the vessel's arrival at Montreal. In these circumstances the Committee have continued the vessel's class on condition that No.3 double bottom tank be not used for oil fuel until the ceiling has been fitted.

Notation of "Fitted for oil fuel 6,47 F.P. above 150°F" has been assigned to the vessel together with records of Docking Survey 6,47 and Shaft Examined 5,47.
