With reference to my memorandum of 7th and your reply of 15th July, please enquire and kindly confirm that the import formalities have now been completed and that this ship is now in the breakers' yard at Valencia.

I apologize for any inconvenience caused by this enquiry but some confusion has arisen regarding her voyages. She has until today, 18th August, appeared in Lloyd's Daily Shipping Index as trading in the Mediterranean, and in view of previous correspondence, I feel this must be erroneous.
