S.S. "PANAGIA SIRIOTISSA" - Constructive Total Loss
Novorossiisk, 10.10.66

We acknowledge with thanks your letter of the 21st December, contents of which were noted. We confirm that this ship has been declared a constructive total loss and is to be broken up.

We give a brief list below of the vessel's movements during the period of management by this company:

1. Delivered Piraeus. Ballasted to Novorossiisk to load Lumber.
2. Novorossiisk to Salonika with lumber. Discharged.
3. Ballasted to Novorossiisk again to load lumber. Whilst in Novorossiisk Roads caught fire and became C.T.L. before loading any cargo.
4. She had been fixed Novorossiisk/Tangier, Casa Blanca with lumber, thence she had been fixed for ground nuts Dakar/Adriatic, but of course these two voyages were not executed.

We hope that this information will prove useful.
