Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in

Temporary Companionway:

A temporary portable companionway for access for forces personnel to shelter tween decks fitted on No.4 hatch, strongly constructed of steel bolted to existing steel hatch cover and portable closing plate provided for fitting over opening in hatch cover when companionway removed. Two openings in companionway, each 5'6" x 39", closed by hinged wood doors, capable of being operated from both sides; sills 4'3" above deck.

This companionway is to be regarded as of a temporary nature, only to be in position whilst the vessel is carrying forces personnel in the above tween decks and is to be removed and the closing plate provided for the purpose is to be jointed and bolted in way of the opening in the steel hatch cover when the vessel is on her normal service.

Sanitary Discharges:

Discharges from additional W.C.s and washbasins in temporary accommodation for forces personnel in shelter tween decks led through ship's sides and fitted with double automatic non-return valves.

Ventilators:

Additional ventilators fitted on shelter deck, coamings to rule requirements and provided with wood plugs and canvas covers.
