Outstanding Conditions of Class: SUBJECT to sternframe at top (E.W. & reinforced 10,57) being specially examined at the next drydocking.

Nature of Present Survey: (~~Afloat~~ and in dry dock)

Docking: Damage (cause unknown) involving shell plating (p & s), bilge keels (p & s) and rudder horizontal coupling.

Recommendation:

SUBMITTED record of 'DS 2,60' be assigned, subject as above, and to indented shell plates F.5 & 6, G.6 & 7, H.5 & 6 (p.s. from fwd), also to bolts in rivet holes being dealt with and shell plates J.4, H.5, 6, 10 & 13 (p.s. from fwd) and H.6, 7, 9, 11 & 13 (s.s. from fwd) and to wastage in flanges of rudder horizontal coupling being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking before ship resumes service.
