Edward James (Newcastle) Limited, attend at their works at Team Valley Trading Estate, Gateshead-on-Tyne, on 19th March, 1952 and subsequently, for the purpose of examining one reconditioned 25 Kw. steam driven Generating set ordered by The Middle Docks & Engineering Co. Ltd., and fitted for s.s. "SAN CASTO".

The engine, manufactured by Messrs. Reader & Co. Ltd., Engine No. 19952, is of the totally enclosed type running on a single cylinder of 8" diam., and a working stroke of 10 1/2 inches, running at 650 R.P.M. with a steam pressure of 130 lbs. square inch, and is directly coupled to a Campbell and Wood generator No. 15320, 25 Kw., 110 V., 227 amps., and wound, drip proof continuously rated.

The generator was examined and tested for insulation resistance, and found to be satisfactory.

The engine was completely opened up for inspection and all components examined and found, or placed, in efficient working order.

There being no facilities for testing generating sets at the Works of Messrs. Edward James Ltd., to complete the survey the generator set should be seen under working conditions.
