6 steel W.T. Hatches fitted over existing upper deck openings at after end of each tank. Opening in deck 2'-0" x 2'-0".

Hatches 2'-6" x 2'-6". Coaming 2'-6" high x 40".

60" steel hinged cover fitted with packing and 4 Joggles.

Nos 2/3 Wing Tanks p.v.s.

(Now W.B. Tanks)

Deck openings reduced to 2'-0" x 18" manhole with bolted plate cover.

Air Pipes

2" Air pipe led from each wing tank hatch coaming into 4" main.

Storm Valve Discharges

Additional S.V. Discharges fitted amidships 1-2½", aft 1-4", 6-2½" and 1-2". All to Rule Regts.

S.V. Discharges from Lock Space have been dispensed with.

Ventilators

2 - 9" Vents and 6 - 6" Vents on fore-castle deck have been dispensed with.
