
Reverting to my letter of the 15th and your reply of the 16th June last regarding the assignment of Convention freeboards to the steamer "SAN CASTO", I beg to inform you I am now in receipt of a report from the Society's Surveyors at Curacao from which it would appear that the new freeboards have been marked on the ship's sides and verified, and the conditions of assignment carried out with the exception of the fitting of the storm valves to the sanitary discharges from the forecastle, which it is understood will be dealt with at the next drydocking in May, 1934.

The Surveyors issued a provisional certificate pending the arrival of the Convention freeboard certificate and certified copy, and the latter were forwarded to them yesterday for issue.
