Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "PAN", I beg to inform you that to complete the Boiler Survey, which became due so long ago as June last, all the safety valves require to be adjusted under steam.

From a communication which I have received from the Society's Surveyor at Bergen, it appears that the vessel has recently been placed on a slipway at that port, and that certain repairs are being carried out, but on the Surveyor offering his services, he was informed that you did not intend to continue the vessel's classification with this Society.

Before the case is submitted to the Committee for consideration I shall be glad to learn what are your intentions with regard to the maintenance or otherwise of the vessel's class in the Society's Register Book, and to be favoured with your reply by return mail.
