I beg to state that the Society's Surveyor at Wellington has duly forwarded to this Office your letter of the 5th ultimo, addressed to him, respecting your steamer "RATA", and having submitted the same for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for this vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
