MARINA. — Kiel, Aug. 11. — Swedish steamer BELE, bound for Stockholm, cargo general, was in collision with Finnish motor vessel Marina, Norrsundet for Rotterdam, cargo general, in Brunsbittelkoog Roads, lower Elbe, Aug. 11. The BELE was slightly damaged but proceeded. Marina has sunk and one crew member was lost; salvage arranged.

Hamburg, Aug. 11. — Finnish motor vessel Marina, Norrsundet for Rotterdam, cargo general, sank last night in lower Elbe near Brunsbittelkoog after collision with Swedish steamer BELE, bound for Stockholm, cargo general. The BELE sustained slight damages but proceeded on voyage. A steward of the Marina was killed.

Hamburg, Aug. 11. — A steward of motor vessel Marina was killed in the collision with steamer BELE last night, while the eight other crew members were picked up after jumping from their sinking vessel into the river. The Marina sank a few minutes after the collision. — Reuter.
