With reference to Liverpool report No.82618 on the Steamer "SCYTHIA". I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them the First Entry Report received from the Barrow Surveyors and that the vessel has been classed 100A1 Shelter deck with freeboard, with notations of LMC 3.21 F.D., C.L., Fitted for Oil fuel 3.21 F.P above 150° F., and Lloyd's A & C P., subject to two Stone-Lloyd watertight doors in Bulkhead No.121 being put in good working order and tested and to the port stern tube being renewed at the first opportunity.

A fresh record of survey 8.21 has also been assigned on Liverpool report No.82618.
