With reference to the Freeboard assigned to the steamer "SCYTHIA" (Messrs Vickers' No. 493) in your letter of the 24th ultimo, I beg to enclose a letter from the Builders from which it will be observed that the question of the passenger accommodation below 'E' Deck has not yet been definitely decided by the Cunard Co., and as a temporary measure, an assignment corresponding to a 30" draft is required.

As the vessel sails for the Continent on Tuesday 22nd instant to be completed, I shall be glad if you will kindly forward as soon as possible an amended assignment together with the Freeboard certificates, the latter to be issued after the markings have been verified.

The usual verification will be forwarded in due course.
