With reference to your letter of the 25th ultimo,
concerning Freeboard Assignment for the above vessel, we would
state that with regard to the maximum Load Line, as the

action of a modified application to the Board of Trade is
under consideration, it will probably modify the deep Load

We propose, as a temporary measure, to mark the
line on the vessel to correspond with the lowest line assigned
by 1'5" below the maximum. This corresponds to a 30'

The centre of the disc will be 15'3" below the top
statutory deck line.

We shall be glad to know that no objection will be
made to our proposal.
