I am directed to acknowledge the receipt of your of the 23rd instant, respecting the subdivision loading for the S.S. "SCYTHIA", Messrs. Vickers' No. 493, and that two alternative lines have been approved for carrying cargo under different conditions.

The freeboard has been assigned to place the centre disc to correspond to the maximum loadline of 31'-5" draught, and an additional line 1'-5" below the centre disc has been assigned to correspond to the approved five moulded draught of 30 ft.

In this case the freeboard has been assigned from the same as that of the "SAMARIA", referred to in my of the 10th December last, and the position of the centre disc will therefore be 13'-10" from the statutory deck above the 2" Veitchi on the steel "D" deck, for all
