Dear Sir,

I beg to enclose herewith Report C.12a on
the "EMPIRE STOUR" ex "HARPENDEN", which vessel is under survey
at this port, and I shall be glad to receive the certificates
of due course.

I may say that the Special Survey No.3 has
been carried out with the exception of the examination of
No.3 Hold (full of coal) and tank top plating in Nos. 1 and 4
Holds (tank top plating covered by sand ballast).

The double bottom tanks in way of the above
have been examined internally and tested, and the bilges have
also been examined and found satisfactory.

The Surveyor will submit to the Committee
that the vessel remain as previously classed in the Register
book and have a record of survey 12,41, and a notation of Gls.
No.3-12,41, subject to No.3 Hold and tank top plating
Nos.1 and 4 Holds being examined, and double bottom tanks
in way tested and indented shell plating being repaired at
the next convenient opportunity.
