This vessel is now under survey on account of damage and it has been noted that she has a Provisional Load Line Certificate, issued at Adelaide, Australia, 18th November, 1940.

The Master states that the vessel was under Survey at Wellington, New Zealand, during August, September and October, 1940, when the Special Survey No. 3 was partly held. It was further stated that outstanding items to complete the Special Survey consists of the Examination and testing of Nos. 3, 4 & 5 double bottom tanks. These tanks are used for the carriage of fuel oil, and it will not be possible to make arrangements for cleaning and testing at this port, and so complete the Survey.

Under the circumstances we shall be pleased to know what arrangements can be made regarding the issuing of a new Load Line Certificate.

It should be added that the vessel expects to sail in the course of a few days.
