Referring to the correspondence from Paris 19.2.1949 on the subject of this Vessel's equipment, I should like to say that the Vessel has recently been docked here and 4 lengths of chain cable were verified and the Vessel now has her complement of 550 metres on board.

The Stream steel wire was verified at this time and shell plate E 7 s.s. part renewed and indented shell plating p & s dealt with.

The set up keel and bottom plating was specially examined and found efficient.

My report on this case will follow, but the Owners have asked for a new Certificate of Class without the subject item of " 60 fms of chain cable and a stream steel wire being supplied ", and I should be pleased if this could be forwarded at your early convenience.
