With further reference to your letter of the 20th December last, respecting the case of the "SAINT BERTRAND" I beg to inform you that the Classification Certificates being on board, the Agency of the Compagnie Générale Transatlantique, at Havre, will send the Classification Certificates to us, on the vessel's return at that Port, for amendment.

Messrs. Cie Générale Transatlantique state that four lengths of chain-cable, duly tested by the Society's Surveyor, have been put on board together with the Stream cable ; and they understand that the corresponding indications will be omitted in the "Subject" items.
