In confirmation of my letter of the 17th inst. I give to you below the translation of a letter I received from the Captain.

I have to inform you that, by a letter from our technical Manager in Paris, we have been advised that orders have been sent to our HAVRE Agency to supply to our steamer, in the shortest possible delay, 30 fathoms of cable-chain of 60mm diam. and 220 meters of 127mm steel wire, in order to obtain the class 100 AI.

The Company accepted definitively the assigned free-board, but it is ascertained that the Custom Office Will add to the Gr. Tonnage the whole of the long forecastle.
