Dear Sir,

Steamer "SAINT BERTRAND"

I am obliged to you for the information contained in your letters of the 24th ultimo and 17th instant regarding this vessel, and with regard to the last named communication I would remark that the weight of the stream anchor as given in your First Entry Report is not in excess of Rule requirements, but can be accepted. The length of the stream chain on board however, is deficient by 55 fathoms.

It would therefore be in order for you to recommend, if necessary, that the vessel's class to be made subject to 30 fathoms of chain cable and additional stream chain being supplied at the first opportunity to bring the equipment into line with the Rule requirements.

The plan of pumping arrangements referred to in your letter of the 15th ultimo is awaited.
