Classification Fees.

Hull. Probable Equipment letter *b+*

Fee for classification Hull = £69 x 2 x 1.75 @ 864 francs/£1
= Fr. 210000

It is submitted the Surveyor be advised that the fee for classification and special survey including First Entry and the dry docking should be twice the normal special survey fee corresponding to the age of the vessel, which would be charged at ~~Newport~~. *New Port.*

On this basis, and at the present rate of exchange, the following fees should be charged:-

Hull - Classification and Special Survey Fr. 210000.

To this should be added the fee for conversion to oil burning and a repair fee commensurate with the amount of work carried out.

Fee for Freeboard renewal - new scale FR. 7000.

Fees for Classification and Special Survey on the above basis:-

Machinery	Fr. 97000
Electrical Installation	Fr. 24000
Screw Shaft	Fr. 9000

The Surveyor should be informed that in addition to Reports 8 and 9 it will be necessary to forward Report 13, First Entry on the Electrical Installation.

NOTE for S. & E.

In the circumstances of this case it is necessary that these reports should be examined as early as possible and the Surveyor advised before the Survey is completed.
