I am in receipt of your letter of the 11<sup>th</sup> instant submitting for the Committee's approval the plan of the single-ended boiler No. 1675 proposed to be made by Messrs Lindsay, Burnett & Co. for Standard Coasting Steamer "C I" Type and in regard thereto, I am directed to acquaint you that, provided the steel to be used in the construction of the boiler be tested as required by the Rules, and the boiler be built and tested in accordance with the plan submitted and with the provisions of the Rules, and to the entire satisfaction of the local Engineer Surveyor, the same will be approved of for the intended working pressure of 130 pounds per square inch.

The plan referred to is returned herewith, and should accompany the reports when transmitted to the Committee.
