I am in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant respecting the steamer "EMPIRE MIGHT" and with regard thereto, think it well to remark it should be made clear to the Greenock Surveyors that the total NHP of 1372 which they have now confirmed, is the figure which will appear in the Register Book and on which the fees for future Special Surveys will be based.

As regards new construction, however, the fee for the LP turbines entered on Glasgow Report No. 65121 is quite correct, but the fee for the remainder of the machinery should be based on an NHP of 1146 which would have been the NHP were no turbines fitted.

It is thought the Surveyors should be advised accordingly as a guide in future similar cases.
