Class 100A1 "With Freeboard" corresponding to a summer moulded draught 18" in excess of that contemplated by the Rules for a Complete Superstructure vessel having a tonnage opening.

Proposals to connect the ends of bulkhead stiffeners by means of angle struts instead of the usual bracket plates were approved for ordinary bulkheads, oil fuel bunker bulkheads and deep tank bulkheads. These arrangements, however, are covered by the approved plans.

There is nothing further in the correspondence, affecting the First Entry, which is not covered by the approved plans.
