S.S. "ASIATIC" Leith Report No. 16,237.

In reply to your classing letter of the 30th ultimo, respecting this vessel, I have to state that the thicknesses of the Poop and Forecastle Side plating in way of and clear of the 24" spacing are as given in the report, in consideration of the Poop Side framing in way of the increased spacing being of 9 X 3½ X .50 Bulb angles, and the framing of the Forecastle Side in way of the increased spacing being of 11 X 3½ X .56 Bulb angles.

The butts of the centre strake of tank top plating and the spacing of the rivets through the frames and shell plating are as approved for multiple punching. The spacing of 6 and 5½ diameters given in the report represent the average multiple "dot and dash" spacing in the case of the former figure. The latter figure represents the spacing in way of the Peak Tanks and in bottom plating forward of the 3/5ths. length.



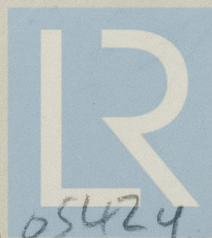
