Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in October, 1942.

REMOVALS:-

Port Side:- Four cowl ventilators (2 - 10" dia., 2 - 6" dia.) on upper deck to
D.E.M.S. accommodation in No. 5 'tween deck, Port side, now permanently
removed. Deck apertures closed with welded spigot plates and satisfactorily
hose tested.

Star Side:- D.E.M.S. Accommodation in No. 5 'tween deck, Starboard side, removed
and access door in after Starboard 'tween deck bulkhead closed with welded
plate. Three cowl ventilators (one 10" dia., two 8" dia.) on upper deck,
three portlights and one storm valve in way removed and openings closed
with welded spigot plates, satisfactorily hose tested on completion.
Cargo battens installed where accommodation removed.
