Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in \_\_\_\_\_ The following has been added to the existing Rpt. C11(contd) on board:

"SWANSEA.

All openings for "Butterworth" type cleaning system (35 in number) now fitted with 6" coamings and watertight bolted cover plates with the exception of one to No. 3 centre tank where situated inside the centre castle which has a bolted watertight cover plate direct to deck. ✓

The 18" diameter flush scuttle on poop deck to steering gear space removed at this time and steel hatch fitted 2' 0" x 2' 0" x 18" high with hinged steel watertight cover. ✓

Shifting boards port and starboard sides of forecastle front have been previously removed and portable hinged steel doors fitted. The channels for the shifting boards have been retained. ✓
