The Main Boiler Survey became due in September, 1959, and in reply to enquiry the Owners stated that the ship was laid up and was being converted to Diesel propulsion.

As there was no record here of the ship having been under survey in this connection they were asked for further information and reminded that the Special Survey becomes due at the end of next month.

In reply they stated as follows:-


