Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo, respecting the case of the Steamer "WESTERN COAST", and have to inform you that the fee chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey of the Hull will be two-fifths of the difference between the fees as a Standard Vessel and the ordinary classification fees, which in this case will amount to say 16.

An account is accordingly being rendered to the Ministry of Shipping for this sum, and on payment your account will be credited accordingly. You will therefore be good enough to see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
