In reply to your letter of the 14th instant with respect to the annual load line surveys, the s.s. "SAN CASTO" is trading in the Gulf of Maracaibo and arrangements could be made with your local Surveyor at Aruba to carry out this survey. We are writing our people in Aruba to communicate with him.

The s.s. "SAN DARIO" - we are considering whether the vessel shall be put through special survey, or not, at Liverpool, and in the event of it being decided to put the vessel through survey the load line certificate will be obtained at the same time.

S.S. "SAN GERARDO" This vessel is expected to dry dock in Falmouth next week when the load line survey will be carried out.

S.S. "SAN LAMBERTO", "SAN LEOPOLDO" and "SAN TEODORO" These vessels are presently laid up in the River Fal and it is possible they may never come into commission again.

S.S. "SAN LEONARDO". This vessel will in all probability be sold for breaking up.

S.S. "SAN ROBERTO". This vessel is due to arrive in the U.K. in February and the load line survey will be put in hand then.
