Dear Sirs,

Your Ref. T.

I have been abroad for a considerable time, and I beg to apologize for the fact that the sums demanded in your letter of the 31st ultimo have not yet been paid. This is due to an oversight. I also assume that your letter does not refer to Yd. No. 54, but to Yd.No.53, as you were good enough to let me know through Mr. Dykes, in a letter dated 7th June last, that the classification fees for Yd. No.54 would not be due before the delivery of the vessel.

For Yd.No. 53, M.S. "CARIPITENO", I have paid £ 148.10-, as per receipt. A further sum was paid for the same vessel by Messrs. Waried of Hamburg directly. I thought therefore that the demanded sums had also been paid. The matter has in the meantime been put right by Mr. Dykes, and I have instructed my Bank to pay you the sum of £ 75.-.-
