We received an account from Mr. Dykes of Gdynia
dated 15th May last amounting to

£.14.---.---

further an account dated 24th May last amounting
to

£.198. 2.---

and at last one of the principal surveyor, Mr. Chisholm of
Hamburg dated 30th May last amounting to

£. 82.---.---

in total £.294. 2.---

In consideration of this very high amount standing
in no relation to the value of the classified vessel, we
asked Mr. Dykes to give us some explanations as regards the
details of these costs. In reply to this he informed us that
in his bill he included the total expenses and the voyages
from Danzig to Memel a.s.o. since 1930 for two vessels. At the
moment there are no further costs for the second vessel.

We therefore again suggest that you should give us
an account only for the first vessel, because the second will
be finished too within a short period. In fact the second
vessel is classified by Mr. Dykes too during the building
period, and as the work on the second vessel has already been
finished for launching purposes, we think that by the unfavour-
able situation caused by cancelling the building contract by
our partners of same there would be no possibility to maintain
that it is our mistake.

If therefore it would not be possible to give us
your normal invoice for the classification works of the first
vessel only, we kindly ask you to wait for the reception of
the money for the second vessel until we have to request the
dressing of the respective certificates for this second
