The First Entry reports on this vessel have recently been received from the Sunderland Surveyors. She was commenced in October 1920 and launched in May 1921, and in accordance with the Rules a date of build of November 1921, i.e. - six months after the date of launch, was assigned by the Classing Committee on the 6th instant.

The Owners, however, write that the steamer was delivered to them on the 30th September, having been in the Builders' hands since she was launched, and in the circumstances they hope the Committee will see their way to make the building date as late as possible.

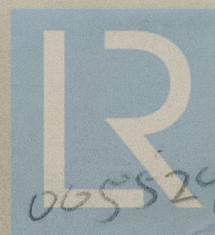
The Sunderland Surveyors, in reply to enquiry, state that the vessel was examined in dry dock on the 21st and 22nd September, 1922, when the bottom, etc. were found in good condition. The Surveyors also state that the completion of the vessel after launching was delayed owing to the original Owners not taking her over and she was subsequently sold to the present Owners.
