The freeboards as set out in your assignment letter dated 10th July last have now been marked on the ship's sides and the conditions of assignment complied with as follows:-

(1) All overboard scupper pipes from the second deck have been fitted with non-detachable screw plugs at the inner ends.

(2) All sanitary discharge pipes from spaces on the second deck have been fitted with second automatic non-return valves accessible at all times.

The freeboard certificate and copies have been issued as instructed and Freeboard Verification Report is enclosed herewith.
