the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owner attend on board of the Netherlands motor vessel "HELENA", 182 tons gross, port of Registry Groningen, whilst lying afloat at Amsterdam on the 27th of March, 1946 for the purpose of testing the loading gear consisting of one derrick hatchway no.1 to 0,5 ton safe working load and one derrick hatchway no.2 to 2 tons safe working load.

The above specified derricks have been tested with an overcharge of 25% and upon careful examination afterwards no distortion or overstrain could be observed on derricks, masts, blocks, shackles, bolts, puttings, rigging, etc.

The derricks have been marked with their corresponding safe working load, viz.:-

derrick hatchway no.1 safe working load 0,5 ton. 27-3-1946

derrick hatchway no.2 safe working load 2 tons. 27-3-1946
