

Dear Sir,

In reply to your classing letter of the 16th. inst. "WAR PIBROCH", and with regard to enquiry contained therein, I beg to state that a semi-box beam was fitted on the fore side of the collision bulkhead on the lower deck stringer of the following size:- plate .48 x .306 connected to bulkhead by $3\frac{1}{2}$ x $3\frac{1}{2}$ x .35 angles and beam on fore side 8 x 3 x .42 Bulb Angles, as required, ^{*I repeat the number*} but that the Poop Deck was not sheathed with wood. $1\frac{1}{2}$ " lining fitted between the beams below the deck as per instructions from D.C.A.S., letter dated 17th. Feb. 1918, also letter from S.P. Austin dated 27th. Mar. 1918.
