E I return herewith the First Entry Machinery Reports (London 80687, Newcastle 70588, Middlesbrough 10029) in the case of the S.S. "WULSTY CASTLE", and with regard thereto I have to point out that the following particulars have been omitted, viz:- the dates of your visits in July, the diameters of the tunnel and screw shafts, whether the screw shaft is fitted with a continuous liner, the number of revolutions at full power of the turbines, motors and propeller, and your recommendation to the Committee.

I have to request that you will report that portion of the survey of this vessel's machinery held by you on the Report 4a, and forward it to this Office at an early date.
