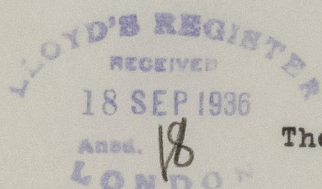

With reference to your freeboard assignment letter dated 6th August last in respect of the steamer "WULSTY CASTLE", I beg to enclose herewith a Rpt.C.12(a).

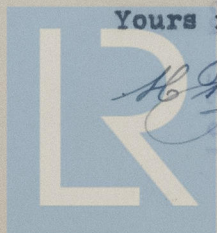
I may add that the following has been carried out:-

- (1) The stiffeners on No.1 hatch coamings supported by stays.
- (2) The scupper pipes leading to the hold bilges from bridge space permanently closed by riveted plates, and overboard scuppers in lieu thereof fitted with storm valves at ship's side.
- (3) Suitable provision provided for rigging life lines.
- (4) The exposed parts of the machinery casing additionally stiffened, as required.
