In August last the Committee agreed to a proposal of the Owners to have these surveys held at the close of the season's navigation on the Great Lakes.

Action was again deferred in February until the opening of navigation, as the vessel was then laid up for the winter.

The New York Office now forwards a letter from the Cleveland Surveyor, from which it appears he has been unable to arrange for the survey to be held, and that the Owners' representative states that it is not the Owners' intention to continue the class of the vessel with this Society.

In the circumstances, the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Friday, 23rd instant, decided to expunge the class with a red line (5.24), indicating non-compliance with the Rules.
