

S.S. "HORACE S. WILKINSON"

This Vessel has been built at Toledo under the survey of the Society's Surveyors with a view to being classed 100 A - "For Service on the Great Lakes", and this class has been assigned by the New York Committee.

From a plan forwarded with the 1st Entry Report it is seen that the method of securing the propeller is an unusual one, but similar to that adopted by the same Engine Builders in the case of the S.S. "INTERNATIONAL".

In the latter case the Committee in March, 1915, assigned the record of * L M C 7-14 subject to the fastening of the propeller to the screw shaft being specially reported upon at each dry docking.

It is submitted that a similar course should be adopted in the present case.
