Correspondence has for some time been taking place between this Office and the Society's Surveyors at Genoa regarding an intimation received in March last from the Owner, at Savona, that he had decided to allow the classification of his vessels with this Society to lapse.

The Genoa Surveyors have had several interviews with the Owner, in which they have called attention to the arrangement which obtains between the Registry of Lloyd's Register, and an effort was made to arrange a synchronisation of the dates of survey in the two.

The Owner has now informed the Genoa Surveyors that while he appreciates the steps taken in the past, he adheres to the decision to withdraw the vessels from Lloyd's Classification. He adds that in February 1923, he is ensuring the utmost economy while maintaining the vessels in service.
