The Copenhagen Surveyors write that in all the deep tanks the requirements of the Rules for the carriage of oil, F.P. above 150° F., as cargo have been complied with.

It is accordingly submitted the notations "Carrying fuel oil F.P. above 150° F. in FPT, after deep tank and tank above APT" and "Carrying vegetable oil in forward deep tanks" be amended to:-

"Carrying cargo oil F.P. above 150° F. in FPT., D.Ts, and tank above A.P.T."
