The machinery survey has been advanced and the following remains to complete the survey.

Examination of forward outboard generator diesel engine.

Fitting of a 70m/m direct bilge suction to the port side of the engine room. Increasing of main generator cables to Rule requirements.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the record of IMC 10,52, when the survey is completed, subject to a 70 m/m direct bilge suction being fitted to the port side of the engine room, and main generator cables being increased to Rule requirements.
