In a letter dated the 9th ultimo Mr. Bennett, the Society's Principal Surveyor for the U.S.A. and Canada, it is stated that it had been learned from the Master of this vessel that she was surveyed and classed by the Norske Veritas in December 1945. Therefore no opportunity was afforded the Society's Surveyors for dealing with the General Examination which became due 3.46.

The matter has been taken up with the Surveyors at Oslo who state they have been informed by the Owners that the vessel has been classed with the Norske Veritas.

It is submitted the class of this vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.
