Ministry of Shipping has been looked into on more than one occasion  
and continued  
in the absence of any information it has been concluded that  
no vessel bearing this name was one of the steamers coming to this  
City, probable from Japan, under another name, which would be  
noted on her arrival here.

receiving attention.
