We made other enquiries from friends who were likely to give information but nothing definite was obtained . -

It appears to be true that Commander FERA is no longer Director General and Sig. FERRARI has been appointed in his place

The group of shareholders Bondi, Luzzato, Fera, are no longer in power and the Odero group may take an active part again shortly . - It is said that most of the Ilva shares are at present in the hands of the Banca Commerciale and Credito Italiano . - The Company may be dissolved and reformed under its present name or another . -
