

Dear Sirs,

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Leghorn respecting the Steamer "VALLARSA", and shall be glad if you will kindly furnish me with any remarks you may have to make in regard to the Owners' statement respecting the vessel's classification.

I may add that in a previous similar case, namely that of the steamer "COLOMBA", No. 55119 in the Register Book, it was understood that the action taken in regard to the classification of that vessel was done without the knowledge of Commander Fera, the Director General of the Lloyd Mediterraneo.

At the same time I have to point out that it will of course be necessary for the two lengths of cable, referred to in Mr. Gori's letter, to be compared with the certificates of test, and if it is found that the Society's requirements in regard to the testing have been complied with the Committee would be prepared to give the case their consideration although the testing of the cables had not
