The Newcastle Surveyors report this vessel has sustained damage to stem and bow plating through collision and was placed on slipway for repairs.

On visiting the vessel the Surveyors were informed by the Superintendent through the Repairers that their services were not required as the class was not to be retained.

A letter has been received from the Owners confirming this.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
